**SUBJECT : Participation in International Races Abroad**

The Malta Triathlon Federation is aware that many of its members and athletes extend their racing experiences to foreign countries. The Malta Triathlon Federation appreciates this fact and encourages anyone who would like to participate abroad. The Malta Triathlon Federation believes that international participation can only elevate the performance of local athletes and thus improve the quality of triathlon in Malta.

In its aim to offer greater support as well as for record purposes, the Malta Triathlon Federation is issuing the directive that, as in the past seasons, any MTF member who shall be participating in an international race is to inform the Federation before the events and follow up with the result as soon as this becomes available. The channel of communication for this shall be followed by filling up the provided form (which is also downloadable from our website on <http://www.triathlonmalta.org/downloads.html>) and return it by email to [info@triathlonmalta.org](mailto:info@triathlonmalta.org) in the stipulated time-frames as listed on the form, before the race and after the event (with the result).

This applies for Multisport Races (Aquathlons, Duathlons, Triathlons, Cross-Triathlons), but in the case of other races (running, cycling, swimming, etc) it is appreciated if the MTF is informed beforehand by email.

The Malta Triathlon Federation would like to clarify that it is imperative for all of its members to comply by this, and is therefore also urging the Club Delegates and Representatives to ensure adherence from their club members.

The MTF reserves the right to take the necessary action for non-compliance, and shall not recognise, award, and confirm any result from races which the MTF is not informed adequately about.

The MTF would like to express its gratitude to its numerous athletes who, in the past, cooperated with this directive and encourages them to do the same during this coming season
